THE ROLE

The Depot Manager will responsible for the facility and stores management of a busy operation. Basic duties will include facility management, stores managements, stock control, and supporting the Delivery teams.

The role will be based at one of our depots, however, travel to other depots will be required.

THE DAY JOB

- You will lead the management of stock ordering process and be accountable holding the correct amount of stock at the right time.
- Managing the day-to-day operations of the depots and stores which incorporates booking in and out of materials/stock/plant and equipment, and organised planning of multiple stock holding locations.
- You will also be involved in regular audits, inventories and stock control activities inclusive of completing usage, loss reports and daily weekly allocations. These should be documented, and records maintained in an organised manner. Keep accurate and updated inventory records (including daily shipments), departmentalised for accounting purposes.
- Ensuring health and safety practices and associated company policies always remain of paramount importance. Inclusive of ensuring equipment is maintained to ensure these standards are met.
- Track deliveries and address any delays with appropriate third-party suppliers.
- Oversee safe storage of products, particularly of delicate items, in order to facilitate the
 effective allocation of products which should be issued in a documented and organised
 way
- Coordinating the recycle process and disposal of waste, in line with our environmental policy
- Assume responsibility for fleet management which includes the ordering of vehicles, arranging livery, and vehicle fit out including vehicle tracking devices.
- Manage the administration process of vehicle tracking, and further, to ensure vehicles are maintained, regularly serviced and have valid certification such as licences and MOT.
 - Collaboration in support of drivers being assessed, driving responsible, and their licences are checked in accordance with our insurance requirements. Support of colleagues in the management of any process which is breached.
