THE ROLE

The Build Supervisor oversees four build teams, each tasked with extending our fibre optic network to a complete town or village. The successful candidate will ensure that the network construction is following our technical specifications, quality standards, and safety standards. They are also responsible for creating and delivering a mitigation plan when we encounter a build challenge.

Responsibilities

Quality control

- Develop and implement a framework for monitoring and recording the quality of the networks being deployed with reference to the project specification.
- Develop and implement a framework for monitoring and recording the quality of the customer installations.
- Identify opportunities to improve quality management across the network, and ensure lessons learnt are transferred to new build projects.
- Monitor stock levels in field personnel vehicles.

Co-ordination

- Work with the build team's Deployment Manager and the Regional Engineering Manager to make decisions about route deviations and cost-saving alternative routes.
- Manage sites when multiple trades are required to attend at the same time.
- Work with the Planning Team for completing surveys and as-built field trips.



Safety

- Carry out safety inductions
- Monitor safe working practices including use of PPE and gas detectors.
- Make sure working environments are safe for Call Flow operatives and the general public.

Developing the team

- Carry out toolbox talks to communicate Call Flow requirements to the Build Teams.
- Identify training requirements; work with the HR Manager to organise courses.
- Manage training records and accreditations and communicate these to the HR Manager.
- Recognise talent in the field and provide mentoring for less experienced team members, with the objective of achieving continuous development.
- Work with Deployment Managers to undertake initial stages of performance improvement and disciplinary processes.

You will have at least 3 years' experience of cabling in BT Openreach ducts and overhead infrastructure, with a good working knowledge of BT Openreach standards and processes for underground safety, working at height and confined spaces. You will also have a working knowledge of best practice Health & Safety.
